PRIMARY TEACHER

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 years Diploma in Elementary (by whatever name known) from a recognized board.

or

(ii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years Bachelor in Elementary Eduacation (B.El.Ed).

or

(iii) Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 2 years Diploma in Eduacation (special education)

or

- (iv) Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education(B. Ed) from any NCTE recognized institution along with six month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE.
- (v) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 1st of July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (vi) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (vii) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. - (iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

NURSERY TRAINED TEACHER

(a) <u>Mandatory Qualifications</u>

- (i) Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training or Diploma in Elementary Education from a Govt recognised institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference is to be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.
- (ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 1st of July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT/ PRT/ or three years as NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(b) Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

- (i) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (ii) Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (iii) Experience in art, craft, cartoon, caricature, puppet making, music, dance etc.

MUSIC TEACHER

(a) <u>Mandatory Qualifications</u>

- (i) Degree in Music from a Govt recognised University.
- (ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 1st of July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such exservicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

SPORTS TEACHER

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

- (i) Degree in Physical Education or its equivalent from any Govt recognised institution.
- (ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 1st of July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

<u>CLERK</u>

- (a) Graduate from a Govt recognised University.
- (b) Typing speed of at least 40 wpm in English.
- (c) Should be in the age group of 25 to 50 years as on 1st of July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years. Serving staff of the School who apply for the post will also be so eligible.
- (g) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English and Hindi.
- (h) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

HELPERS

- (a) Only the following categories of Helpers (erstwhile Multi-Tasking Staff) are to be employed as per the scale authorized as per Para 7(d), Chapter 4. Henceforth, only the following trade categories of Helpers are permitted:-
 - (i) Ayah
 - (ii) Peon
 - (iii) Gardener
 - (iv) Sweeper
- (b) No educational qualifications are laid down. However, candidates should be selected keeping in view suitability for trade duties.
- (c) Should be in the age group of 21 to 40 years as on 1st of July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (d) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (e) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (f) Candidates with at least two years continuous service in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School, subject to a maximum of two years.
- (g) BOO must satisfy itself about the genuineness of the date of birth of the candidates.
